In Program Matters, the Board:

- Approved the recertification of the Shared Decision Making Plan; and,

In Personnel Matters, the Board:

- Approved the termination of Anne Frauenberger (food service);
- Accepted the resignation of Melody Kearney (math);
- Approved permanent appointments of Irene VanWie, Cleaner; Donna Kenny, Secretary, and, Amy McDonald, clerk typist;
- Approved the reduction of a food service position from 3.5 hours to 3.0 hours and the increase of a food service position from 3.25 hours to 3.75 hours;
- Approved various substitutes for the 2009-2010 school year; and
- Approved various annual appointments of coaches/advisors and volunteers for the 2009-2010 school year.

In Business Matters, the Board:

- Approved the Employment Agreement for the Chief of Curriculum, Instruction and Assessment;
- Discussed the draft rollover budget for 2010-2011;
- Approved the senior citizen/disabled exemption;
- Accepted various donations;
