Following is our weekly schedule for Monday, 1/25/10 – Friday, 1/29/10:

Regularly scheduled classes will be held on Monday, 1/25/10 and Friday, 1/29/10.

On Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday; 1/26-1/28/10 only those students who are taking Regents exams need to report to school.

On Friday, 1/29/10 all students will report to their regular classes, with the exception of those students who are taking Regents exams that day. They will be excused from their classes to take the exam during the testing time.

The schedule appears in chart format below. Please read over the exam schedule below and check the times that each exam is taken. Please note that buses will be picking up and dropping off students as normal.
